

Nevada TACSEI Train-the-Trainer Agreement Form

Nevada was selected to partner with the Technical Assistance Center on Social Emotional Intervention (TACSEI) to build state capacity to develop, implement and sustain a statewide professional development system to enhance the ability of early childhood professionals to use evidence-based practices for supporting children's emotional and social competence.

Nevada TACSEI has provided training to over 2000 participants around the state since March 2011. In order to continue with the process of building a statewide professional development system, we are now recruiting for Nevada Pyramid Model Trainers and Coaches.

Application process: The NV TACSEI Team is soliciting applications from individuals working in a variety of organizations; including parent organizations, mental health/behavioral health, early intervention, early care and education, and higher education. Trainers will be selected based on their application, resume, and ability to demonstrate commitment to conducting Pyramid Model training. Selections will be announced by September 3, 2012.

The attached application includes the NV TACSEI vision and mission statement, information about NVTACSEI Trainer qualifications and required commitment to the NV TACSEI initiative, and the application form.

• Education – Bachelor's or Master's degree in Early Childhood Mental Health, Early Childhood Education, Early Childhood Special Education, or a related field.
